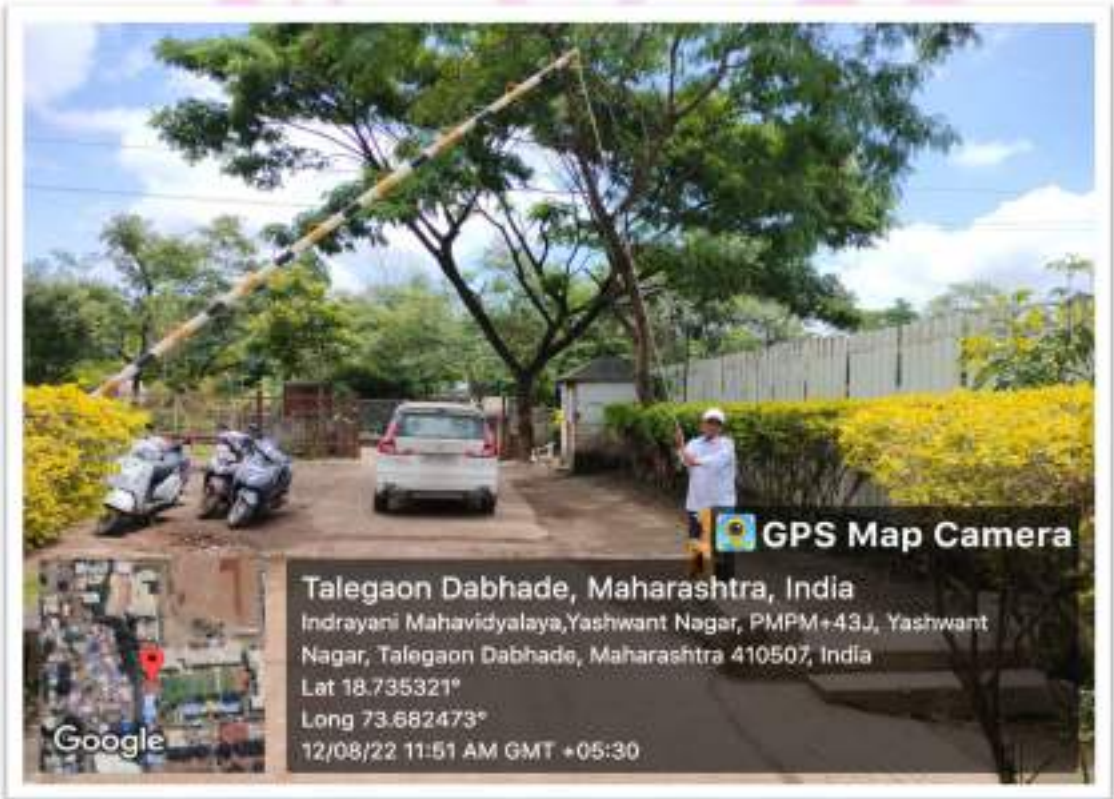

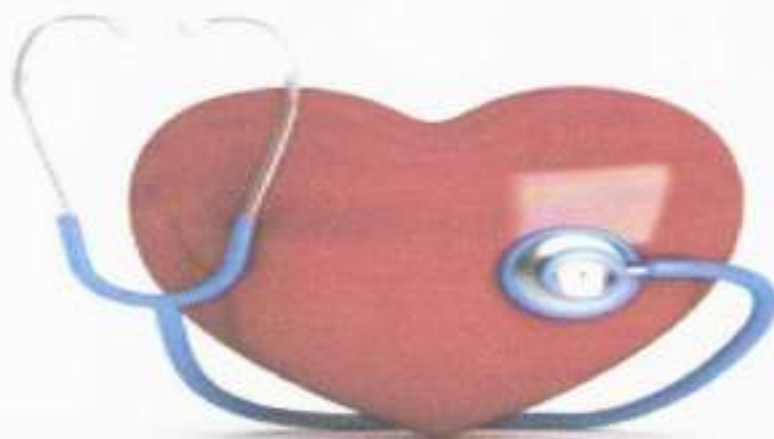

Professor. Smita Lele has over 40 years experience in Industry, Academics, Research, Administration and entrepreneurship as well. She is currently Emeritus professor at the Institute of Chemical Technology. Formerly she was the Director ICT, Marathwada Campus, Jalna.

Prof. Lele has served ICT in various capacities:

- Coordinator of the M.Tech. in Bioprocess Technology programme (2004-2008)
- Head of the Department of Food Engineering and Technology (2008-2012); initiated the M.Tech. in Food Biotechnology programme
- Controller of Examinations (2012-2014)

- Registrar (2014-2018); initiated psychometry assessment of students and recruits and started the Day Care Centre on campus for children of ICT staff, faculty members and students
- Director of ICT's first off-campus at Marathwada, Jalna (2018-2020); formulated mission and vision of ICT-MARJ and contributed immensely to image building of the new campus

Prof. Lele has successfully mentored 2 Start-up units on food processing (i) Trilok Food Satara (since 2012), (ii) Sawarde Valley Food Foundation Chiplun Ratnagiri (Section 8 company, since 2017). The products developed and marketed under Justsip, Justeat, Bigmeal and Frutine brands are novel, healthy, tasty and affordable. All the projects involve 4 win approach – making farmers, processor, Consumer and the society happy. During COVID pandemic, Pune Municipal Corporation chose some of these products for giving to the patients due to its healthy, tasty, affordable nature. The products have a shelf life of 6 months or more without addition of any chemicals or Prof. Lele has many “First” to her credit. She was the First woman Engineer to work for Unilever (then Hindustan Lever Ltd) way back in 1977. She developed and maintained the first website of ICT – www.udct.org in the period 2001-2005, also wrote application on behalf of ICT for IMC Bajaj Quality Award – a process that ran over almost for 1 year. She also compiled ICT annual report in that period and participated in making first formal Vision Mission statements for the Institute. This training helped her to take up that challenge of becoming the Founder Director of ICT Marathwada Campus at Jalna in year 2018. Under her able leadership in just a span of 2 years, the new campus developed an excellent academic and research culture. Through outreach activities she has made an impact in Marathwada region in the educational field and signed many MOUs.

Prof. Lele is a multifaceted personality and she has an extraordinary passion for outreach activities to inculcate scientific temper in the society, to guide students for appropriate career selection and educate house-wife to use science in kitchen and thus improve quality of life. She has been a believer of PSR- personal social responsibility since her student days and has been a member and office bearer, Board member, president etc. of several professional bodies such as Indian Women Scientists Association, AFST, BRIS etc. She has been conducting National Sc Day programs for High school students for last 2 decades and continues the

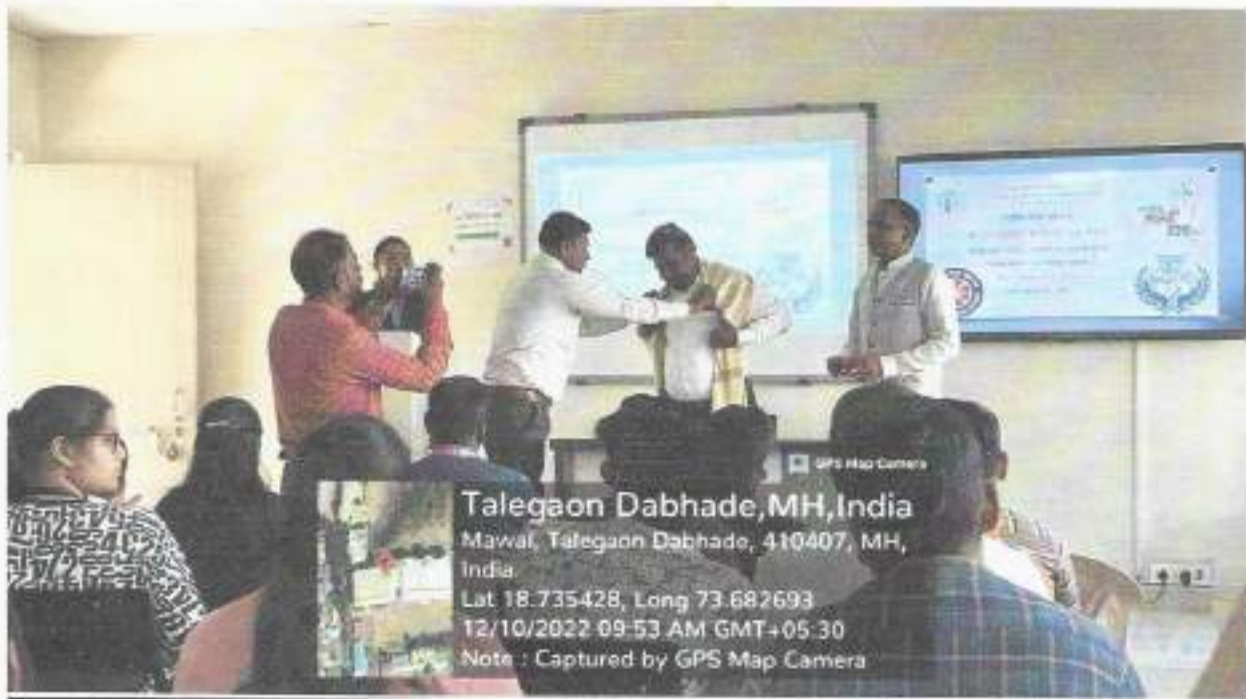

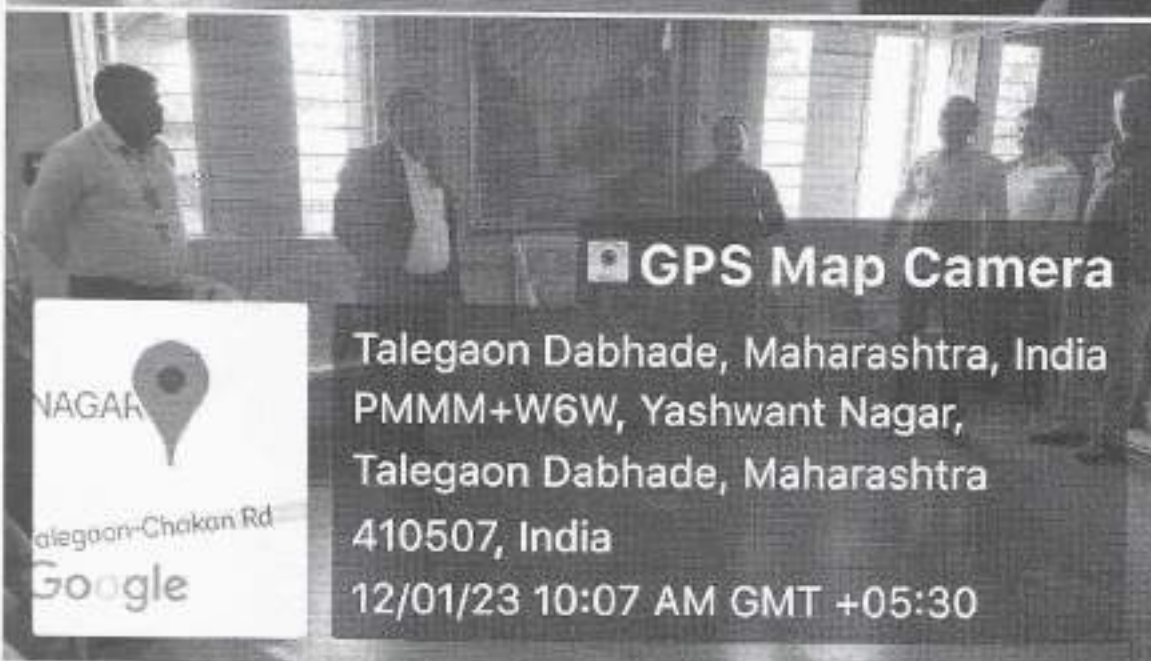
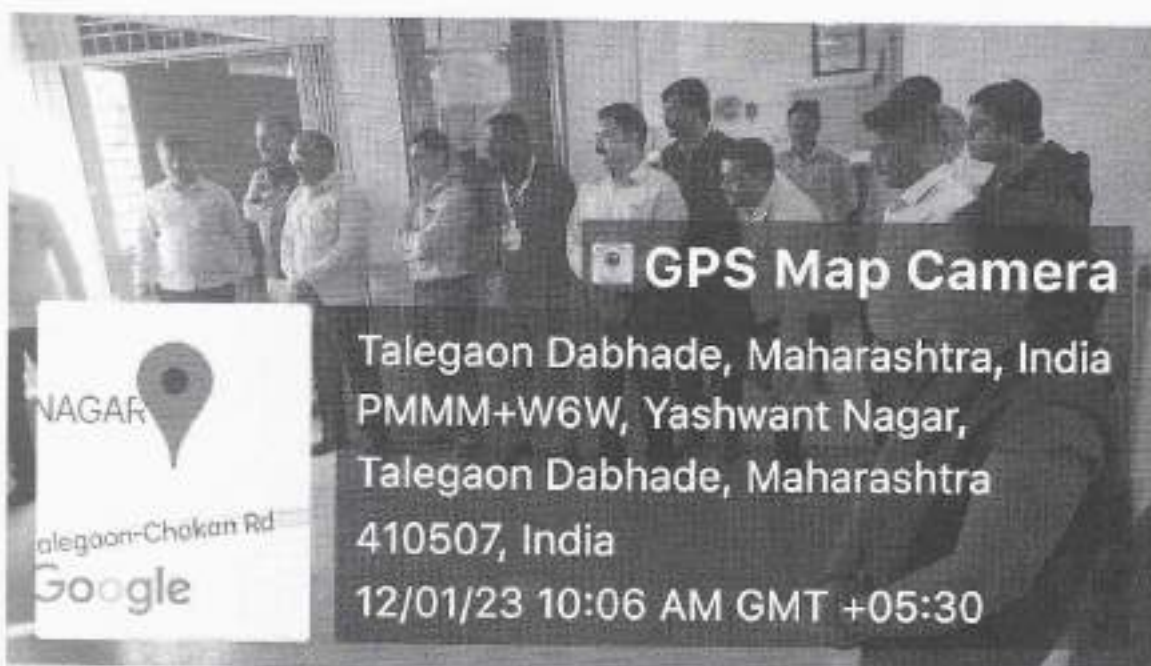
-: Brief Report:-

Commerce Festival 2023 was inaugurated on Monday dated 27/03/2023 by the hands of Mr. Ramdas Kakade, well known Industrialist in Maval and President, Indrayani Vidya Mandir (IMV) and Mr. Rajeshji Mhakse, Managing Director, Mask Polymers Private Ltd. at 09:30 a.m. in the Kantilal Shah School Auditorium. This four days festival was organised by the Department of Commerce of Indrayani Mahavidyalaya. For the inaugural ceremony Mr. Chandrakant Shete, Secretary, IMV Mrs. Nirpua Kanitkar CDC Member, Dr. Aroate, BPharm Principal Dr. S. K. Malghe, Principal Prof. R. R. Bhosale HOD- Commerce, all the faculty members of arts and commerce and students were present.

Programme begun with Saraswati Poojan and felicitation of chief guests.

- **GUEST LECTURE (Coordinator Prof.D.P.Kakade)**

Mr. Rajeshji Mhakse, begun his speech on 'Starts up' with his own experience as an entrepreneur and it was motivational. Mr. Rajeshji Mhakse, began his career as a mechanical engineer in a company. In his 10 years of service he experienced various ups and downs. He worked in 5 to 6 different departments of company viz. Production, R&D, Product Design, etc. where he got valuable exposure to all aspects rubber industry. Thereafter he realized that he must start his own business unit and accordingly in 1998 he started his unit in area of just 300 square feet with only one employee. Now in 2023 the company is spreaded over 3,00,000 square feet and 600 plus employees. He is Chairperson two engineering colleges and also the President of Rubber Manufacturers Association.

He informed, in last year in India, near about 80,000 starts up have been registered and this trend is going to exceed 1,00,000 in the coming years as there are huge opportunities after 'Corona Pandemic'. He also informed that success ratio of starts up in India in between 4% to 5% (in other words 95 starts up out of 100 fail to sustain and grow) and shared the reasons for the failure of starts up. He informed technology is changing very speedily with unprecedented rate. So advised starts up must test the feasibility study and if someone ignores it then he may be putting his business into trouble.

He said Indian youths have technical skills but lacks managing skills, lack of long term financial planning, failure to marketing and dealing with legal issues. He informed that he is going to start 'Starts up Incubation Center' in Talegaon in the coming six months where he will motivate school students from 8th class onwards covering college going students. He urged the need to prepare Project Report for which services of finance experts are available in the market. He explained the huge requirements of different types of customers in the world market with appropriate examples.

Mr. Ramdasji Kakade, share numerous examples with students. He stressed the need to read more and more and get upgraded. He informed that entire worlds' industries are looking at India as 'China + 1' with great expectations so there are huge opportunities for Indian youths.

He shared his views, experiences and expertise on entrepreneurship. He disclosed few secrets of his success with audiences. He said if one is strongly determined and firm then he will definitely succeed in cut-throat competition. He advised do not get frightened and feared with experience of failure. He also informed that our dependency on China accounts for 16% of total imports so the Government of India also changed the perception and started motivating Indian Youth to start their own business units to reduce such huge dependency on China.

Prof. D. P. Kakade, Ms. Sakshi Natak (TYBCom) and Ms. Bhumi Tiwari anchored the programme and Ms. Bhumi expressed vote of thanks.

Report on Guest Lecture On Role of HR in Business & Industries on 29/03/2023

On day three of the commerce festival i.e., Wednesday dated 29th April 2023 lecture of Mr. Avinashji Ghule, Human Resource Professional, Magna Automotive India Private Ltd. on 'Role of HR in Business and Industries' was organised. The session was presided over by Dr. S. K. Malghe, Principal, Indrayani Mahavidyalaya. For this session Prof. K.V. Adsul, HoD Dept. of Economics Dr. M. V. Deshmukh HoD Dept. of Hindi, faculty members of Arts and Commerce and students were present.

Program began with Saraswati Pujan and felicitation of chief guest by the hands up Principal Dr S. K. Malghe. In his introductory speech Prof. D. P. Kakade expressed his opinions on the importance of role played by HR in industries in today's competitive world. He urged students to understand the guest lecture carefully as it will provide them not only an insight to the functioning of HR Department in industries but also explore the career opportunities in HR.

In his speech, Mr. Ghule explored the historical background of HR. He explained how the number of workers in agriculture is reducing while there is significant increase in the agricultural output with less labour to feed the vast population of India. He said HR has dominance in the field of manufacturing and service industries today. But two to three decades ago the term HR was not existed it was the role of personal management which HR plays today.

His speech maybe divided into the following stages:

- 1. Hiring:** HR Professional has to not only ascertain the number of work force required but the skills set required from these workers considering need of the organisation. HR professional has to set certain or norms to identify the right candidate for the right job to suit the needs of the organisation.
- 2. Performance:** He shared an example of Russian economy- how it failed on economic front and lost the its status of Industrialised Nations in the world due to the protection given in the job and salary by the government. He said this protection has resulted into laziness and indifference among the workforce in the Russian Industries. He said to sustain in the career and growth one has to continuously add value to the organisation as there is Performance Management System existed in every organisation. One who fails to make value addition will not be continued in the services and business.
- 3. Learning and Development:** Mr. Ghule informed students whatever they have learned in schools and colleges will not last longer for the entire life. He said rather persons learn more in the business organisation than what they have learned in the schools and colleges. HR

professional has to know and understand the upcoming new trends in technology and skills set required for the same. He explained the difference between the achievements of two or more candidates who had educated from the same school and colleges 10 years before. He stated high achievers have taken greater (and more) efforts for their own development and the positions they enjoy today in the society.

4. Compensation and Benefits: HR Professional determines salary, wages and benefits payable to every individual in the organisation say from new entrants or helper to senior most personal or senior most officer or manager in the organisation. While ascertaining the wages and benefits HR professional considers factors like inflation, cost of living, current trends in the industry, budgetary allocation, employees skills knowledge and experience etc.

5. Industrial Relations: Mr. Ghule informed that before year 2000, 90% percent of the work of HR was concentrated on maintaining harmonious and peaceful relationship between (workers) trade unions and management. To maintain healthy relations between workers and management HR professional must have sound understanding various acts and statutory provisions benefiting the workers. He says if there is a conflict between workers and management then no such organisation will not achieve its goals.


6. Legal Compliance: For HR professional it is extremely essential to have sound understanding of the prevalent acts regulating industries such as Trade Unions Act, Factories Act, Minimum Wages Act etc. He informed HR strategies are designed and defined in corporate office of the enterprises.

7. Changing Role of HR: Majority of organisations today have outsourced their office work, so there is a significant change in the roles of HR professionals. HR professional must have, at least basic knowledge of organisational functions like finance, marketing, logistics etc. The work of HR is more of thinking nature than the physical work. If you do not perform no one is going to spare you that is protect you in the job. He said number of degrees does not necessarily make one employable. Good interactive & people skill will promote person to next level.



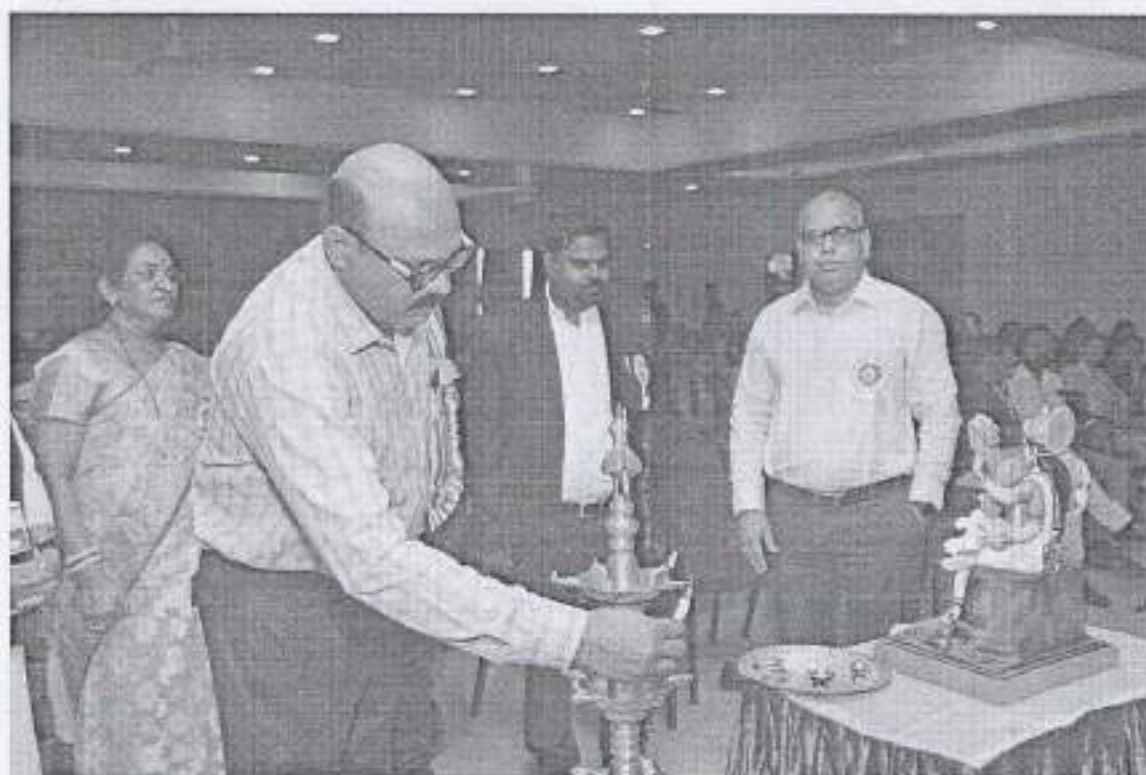


