## INTRODUCTION

National Service Scheme, popularly known as NSS, was launched under the aegis of the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports (MYAS), Government of India in the year 1969, which was the birth centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi, the Father of the Nation. The scheme was launched simultaneously in 37 Universities involving about 40,000 students. It primarily focused on the development of the personality of students through community service and promotion of national solidarity in the country. The idea of involving students in the task of national service dates back to the times of Mahatma Gandhi. He exhorted the students to remain conscious of their social responsibility. The duty of the students should be to prepare themselves for final dedication to the service of fellow countrymen rather than just treating this period of study as one of the opportunities for indulging in intellectual luxury. Advising them to form a living contact with the community in whose midst their institution is located, he suggested that instead of merely undertaking academic research about economic and social disability, the students should do “something positive, so that the life of the villagers might be raised to a higher material and moral level”. Currently, the College is running two NSS units with around 206 student volunteers and two NSS Programme Officers. The year 2020-21 was marked with the prevalence of deadly COVID-19 pandemic that witnessed the remarkable contributions made by the NSS volunteers in the field of mask distribution, sensitization programmes related to COVID-19 norms. The NSS Units wholeheartedly involved themselves in protecting the environment by conducting activities in consonance with the vision of ‘Swachh Bharat Abhiyan’ programme of the Government of India. The College takes pride in nurturing students who orient themselves towards community service and work dedicatedly to become the agents of change.

I. The operational aim of NSS is to integrate the three basic components of the programme. NSS programmes should provide a variety of learning experiences, which must develop a sense of participation, service and

achievement among the volunteers. The activities should aim at the following:

Making education more relevant to the present situation to meet the felt needs of the community and supplement the education of the university/college students by bringing them face to face with the rural situation.

- II. Providing opportunities to the students to play their role in planning and executing development projects which would not only help in creating durable community assets in rural areas and urban slums but also results in the improvement of quality of life of the economically weaker sections of the community.
- III. Encouraging students and non-students to work together along with the adults in rural areas.
- IV. Developing qualities of leadership by discovering the latent potential among the campers, both students as well as local youth (Rural and Urban), with a view to involve them more intimately in the development programmes and also ensuring proper maintenance of the assets created during the camps.
- V. Emphasizing dignity of labour and self-help and the need for combining physical work with intellectual pursuits.
- VI. Encouraging youth to participate enthusiastically in the process of national development and promote national integration through corporate living and cooperative action.
- VII. While undertaking these activities, each NSS Unit should envisage its programmes/activities aiming at instilling discipline, building character, promotion of physical fitness and development of culture.

PM Narendra Modi launched the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan 8 years ago on 2nd October 2014 following the path shown by Mahatma Gandhi. A Swachh Bharat was one of Gandhiji's dearest dreams and it was his belief in the cause, which made our country come so far ahead in this journey. There were almost 550 million people practicing open defecation till 2014; 250 million of them no longer practice open defecation. The mission of the program isto focus on sanitation,cleanliness and to eliminate open defecation in India by 2019. Sanitation coverage has already gone up from 42% in October 2014 to 60% in May 2017. The Abhiyan is divided into urban and rural missions taken over by Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) and Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation (MDWS) respectively. The national movement for 'Swachh Bharat' can also be viewed as 'Swastha Bharat' as it comprises of a series of public health initiatives towards practicing preventive health.

Indrayani Vidya Mandir's IndrayaniMahavidyalaya celebrated birth anniversary of the great leaders, Lal Bahadur Shastri who gave the slogan of Jai Jawan Jai Kisan as well as Gandhi's 154 birth anniversary was celebrated with great enthusiasm by the National Service Scheme Department. 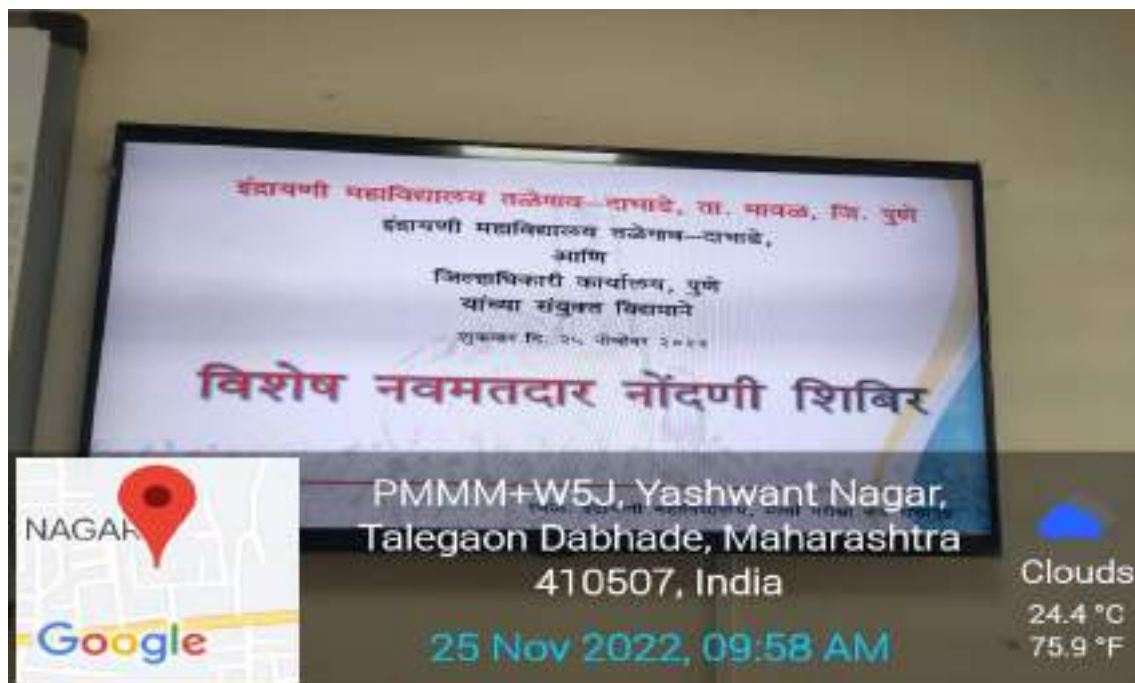

The work of the forest department in protecting wild animals is challenging as well as glorious. It is a good thing that the government is emphasizing on vaccination to prevent the spread of 'Lumpi' disease to other animals, asserted Chandrakant Shete, Indrayani Vidya Mandir Sansthan.

He was speaking on the occasion of the inauguration of the 'World Wildlife Week' organized jointly by Indrayani Vidya Mandir Sanstha, College, Forest Department of Government of Maharashtra, Forest Park Vadgaon Maval and Wildlife Protector Maval. On this occasion Forest Officer of Vadgaon Maval

Parikshetra of Forest Department Hanumant Jadhav, H. A. Khatke, M. B. Date, D. B. Thombre, T. A. Dhembare, Jigar Solanki, College Principal Dr. SambhajiMalghe, President of Wildlife Protector Maval Institute Nilesh Garade, Head of BBA BCA Department Prof. Vidya Bhegde, Head of History Department Dr. Pramod Borade, Forest Department Officer

College Principal Dr. SambhajiMalghe said in the introduction that everyone needs to take an oath that 'wildlife protection is my responsibility'. Wildlife faces many threats from humans. We are importing animals for our selfishness. It is regrettable that around 85 species of birds are extinct today. He also said that the birds have become homeless due to tree felling.

Hanumant Jadhav introduced the animals of the mawla like vultures, leopards, gawas, owls. He said that the food chain of animals is disturbed and they come out of the forest. Leopard is not our enemy but our friend. Today, animals are being hunted illegally, the government should cooperate to stop it. He also expressed his feeling that Nilesh Garade's 'Wildlife Protection Maval Sanstha' is cooperating with the government in Vadgaon Maval. He also appealed to everyone to plant trees on the occasion of birthdays, wedding ceremonies and other events.

Ganesh Misal said, wildlife protection is playing an excellent role in Maval taluka. Even today, most of the wild animals are being hunted in Maval. He also expressed the feeling that the organization is taking the initiative to create awareness in the minds of people about it.

M. Khatke informed that under the Wildlife Act, 1972, the animals have been given shelter as per the provisions of the law. Catching, killing wildlife and destroying its habitat also come under the definition of the law, so it is necessary to look closely at wildlife. Each animal has different characteristics. Their preservation is the need of the hour. He gave inspiration to create awareness by telling the reasons why animal species like cheetah, taras, vultures, tigers, lions, snakes etc. are getting destroyed in an interesting manner. There is a need to understand the superstitions about animals in the society and to conserve them.

Jigar Solanki gave information about the animals of Maval taluka. He urged to contact the toll free number 1926 of the Forest Department during emergencies by giving information about leopards, taras, wild boars, wild cats, gawas, udmanjars, sambars, poisonous snakes.

To make this program successful Prof. Vidya Bhegade, Dr. Pramod Borade worked hard. On this occasion, the students were honored with certificates on

behalf of the participating institutes. President of the organization Ramdas Kakde greeted the program.

Today, women are seen working shoulder to shoulder with men in all fields. Its origin lies in the life struggle of Kranti Jyoti Savitribai Phule. Mahatma Jyotiba Phule first taught Savitribai the lessons of education and she took the Ganga of education to women. Chandrakant Shete, Executive Officer of the prestigious Indrayani Vidya Mandir Sanstha, expressed that the contribution of women in the development of the country is valuable.

Chandrakant Shete was speaking as the President in a program organized to felicitate Savitribai Phule on her 192<sup>nd</sup> birth anniversary at Indrayani College of Indrayani Vidya Mandir Sanstha.

On this occasion, Principal of Indrayani College, Dr.SambhajiMalghe, Program Officer of National Service Scheme, Prof. Deepti Pethe, Prof. Satyajit Khandge and other dignitaries were present. Prof. Khandge said that Savitribai Phule had to go through a lot of struggle because a woman coming forward and teaching girls was not interesting to the then society.

Dr. Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar popularly known as Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar was a social reformer, advocate and politician. He is also known as the father of the Indian constitution. 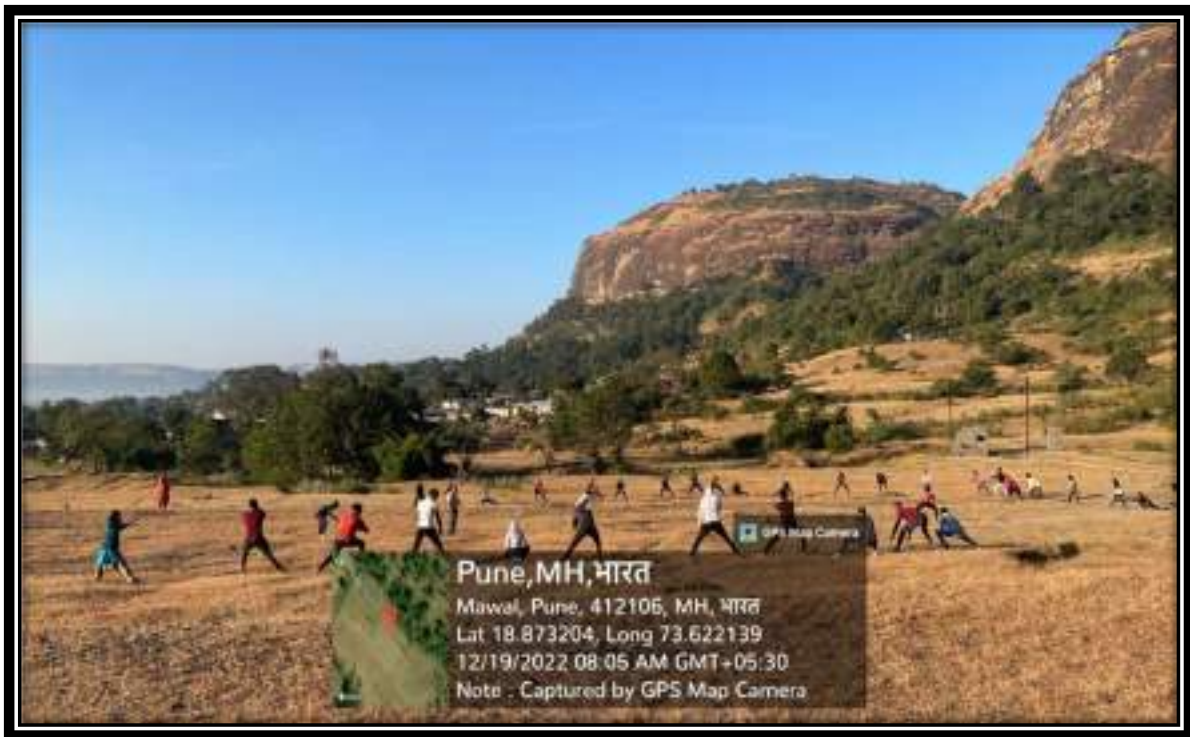
